Motion ordered that **ROBERT BAILIFF**, **THOMAS BAILIFF**, Jesse Smith, John Bronsford, and David Davis I appointed to view and mark an alteration in the motion in the plan where the River Road to Lancaster was at **Fred. Dukins** a farmer to do the least injury to his farm consistent with the public good and make it to next Court.
