SAM O. QUARLES & ULM FLOYD came this day with their attorneys and also a jury of good and lawful men to wit. GEORGE W. PARKISON, WILLIAM SHUMAKE, THOMAS WRIGHT, WILLIAM STROTHER, JOHN KIRBY, JOHN BELFLOUR, WILLIAM Y. CALLICATE, BARTLET JAMES, **THOMAS BAILIFF**, FORLY BROOK SHIES, JOSEPH HALE & JOHN GRISHAM who being tested and SIMON the truth to speak upon their oaths do say that they find the issues in favor of the plaintiff and they do assign the plain damage by the detention of the debts in the declaration mentioned to SIX DOLLARS FORTY FIVE and HALF CENT binds his cost. It is therefore considered by the court that this plaintiff moving against the defendants ONE HUNDRED & SEVENTEEN DOLLARS THIRTY SEVEN and ONE HALF CENTS. The debt in the declaration mentions and his damages aforesaid by the jury aforesaid issues and his cost by him about his suit in this to be recorded.
