

**THOMAS BAILIFF OF SMITH COUNTY TENNESSEE GRANTED SIXTY TWO  
ACRES BETWEEN SMITH FORK AND BOWLING BRANCH 1837**

THE STATE OF TENNESSE NO. 14425

To all to whom these presents shall come, greeting.

Know ye that by virtue of an entry made in the Entry Takers office of **SMITH COUNTY** pursuant to an act of the General Assembly of this state passed **9<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY 1830** & entered **20 NOV 1832** by 1716 here is granted by the said State of Tennessee unto **THOMAS BAILIFF OF S. GREGORY** a certain Tract or Parcel of Land containing **SIXTY TWO ACRES** by survey bearing the date the **29<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF NOVEMBER 1832** lying in said county on the ridge between **SMITH FORK & BOWLING BRANCH**. Beginning on a lynn **JESSE SMITH** SW corner in said **BAILIFF'S C.B.** line then east twenty three poles to a white walnut the north sixty two poles to a berry & buckeye **CONGOS** S.W. corner of his other tract of property then South sixty three poles to **BREKANS** N.B. line then West with the same one hundred and seventy three poles to Sd. **BAILIFF** S.E. corner then North twenty one poles to the beginning.

With the hereditaments and appurtenances. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land, with its appurtenances to the said **THOMAS BAILIFF** and his heirs forever.

In witness thereof **NEWTON CANNON** Governor of the State of Tennessee, hath here with set his hand and caused the Great Seal of the State to be affixed at Nashville on the **16<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF JUNE IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND THIRTY SEVEN**. And of the independence of the United States the 61<sup>st</sup>.
