NOTE: This THOMAS BAYLY is probably a brother of EDWARD BAYLY BAYLIFF who came to Chester County, Pa., in time to be taxed in 1740. It appears EDWARDS name changed about the time he arrived in West Bradford Twp., Chester County, Pa, from BAYLY to BAYLIFF. This JOHN WATSON is likely a grandfather of JAMES WATSON who sold REBECCA BAILIFF land in Orange County, North Carolina for sons THOMAS and ABNER in 1785.
