

**THOMAS BAYLY AND JOHN WATSON REPRESENT THE CONGREGATION AT
DONEGAL FOR THE PRESBYTERY 1720**

1720. The following people were appointed to attend the **PRESBYTERY** from the **CONGREGATION AT DONEGAL: THOMAS BAYLY** and **JOHN WATSON**.

NOTE: This **THOMAS BAYLY** is probably a brother of **EDWARD BAYLY BAYLIFF** who came to Chester County, Pa., in time to be taxed in 1740. It appears **EDWARDS** name changed about the time he arrived in West Bradford Twp., Chester County, Pa, from **BAYLY** to **BAYLIFF**. This **JOHN WATSON** is likely a grandfather of **JAMES WATSON** who sold **REBECCA BAILIFF** land in Orange County, North Carolina for sons **THOMAS** and **ABNER** in 1785.
