BAILIFF, BAILY, BAYLESS LAND DEEDS IN ORANGE COUNTY, NC Compiled By: Ron Cornwell

- 1. 1754 an act was passed in Orange County, NC, establishing the site of the courthouse on the lands of **JAMES WATSON** near where the Indian Trading Path crossed the Enos River. The town laid out here was later named Hillsborough. **JAMES WATSON** purchased a lot in town of Hillsborough in 1757. In 1766 **Robert Watson** bought a lot.
- 2. Feb-1765. Grand jury sworn: Benjamin Long (foreman), Henry Fuller, John Lawson, Daniel McDaniel, **THOMAS BAILIFF**, Barnaby Cabe, John Latty, John Miles, **David Steel**, George Tate, Edward Willison, Peter Noe, Robert Carson, Enoch Bradley. - 3. 1765-1768. A petition from the "Regulators" of Orange County, NC, was sent to the Governor of NC. They were protesting the tax on land purchases in Orange County. **Thomas Baily's** name was on the list.
- 4. 11 Feb 1768. The will of **William Serjant Sr** states his daughter **Elizabeth** got **100 acres** which he purchased from **Thomas Bailey**. SOURCE: Orange County, NC, Wills.
- 5. 1 May 1771. **JAMES BALLIF** is listed with **Lawrence Thompson's Company** in North Carolina's militia in which the state militia defeated the regulators who rebelled over taxes. Most of the regulators left Orange County and went west. SOURCE: The State Records of North Carolina by Walter Clark, Vol XXII.
- 6. 1779. The 1779 Orange County, NC, tax list shows **Claudius Bailey**, **James Bailey** and **John Bailey**.

Witness: John Smith, Henry Hasting, Thomas Mulholland. Proved November 1791 term by Mulholland.
