Watson to Baliff.

This Indenture made this 21st day of August in the year of our Lord 1785. Between J[ames] WATSON of the state of North Carolina and County of Orange of the one part and THOMAS BALIFF by REBECCA BALIFF his mother and natural guardian of the same place of the other part. Witnesseth that the sd. JAMES the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge, hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enseossed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell, alien and confirm unto the said THOMAS his heirs and assigns forever that tract or parcel of land CONTAINING 150 ACRES, situate, lying and being in ORANGE COUNTY on WATSON CREEK. Beginning at a Black Jack running South 23 chains B.O. then E. 43 chains B.O. then North 43 West of then West 77 chains P.O. then South 20 chains P.O. then West 20 chains to the first station CONTAING 150 ACRES OF LAND by the same more or less. It being part of 300 ACRES OF LAND for which the said JAMES hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year above written.
