And now on this day comes **THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS** and the said Defendant being arraigned and put upon his trial for a plan saith he is greatly in the manner and form changed in said Indictment.

It is therefore considered by the Court that said defendant made his fine to **THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS** in the term of twenty dollars and that he pay the costs of this prosecution and remain in custody until said fine and costs and paid or reprised.

Whereupon came said Defendant with JAMES BENNETT his security and in open court acknowledged themselves to owe and be indebted to THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS in the fine sum of fifty dollars if default shall be made in the payment of the above fine & cost within five months from this date. Ordered that the collection hereof be staged for the space of five months.
